Home Safe Programs and Services

24-hour Helpline:

For questions, support and referral for students 24/7.

Resource Room:

Open 9-6 M-F. Students can drop in to a comfortable, student centered space for information, support and referral.

Speaker's Bureau:

Home Safe staff are available to give talks on a variety of violence prevention themes for residence halls, student organizations, sororities and fraternities, and classes.

Community Service:

Home Safe Peer Advocates staff the Helpline, work in the Resource Room, serve on the speaker's bureau, staff information tables, provide student leadership for awareness activities, coordinate Home Safe projects and serve on the Home Safe Advisory Board.
