## Arizona Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) 2013 and 2015

Created 9/1/16

The Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) monitors priority health risk behaviors that contribute to the leading causes of death, disability, and social problems among youth and adults in the United States. The national YRBS is conducted every two years during the spring semester and provides data representative of 9 through 12 grade students in public and private schools throughout the United States. The data below were gathered from the Youth Risk Behavior Survey administered throughout Arizona in 2013 (n=1,579) and in 2015 (n=2,575). The Arizona YRBS is sponsored by the Arizona Department of Education and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
